U.S. Sample Grade
 U.S. Sample Grade shall be soybeans which:

- a) Do not meet the requirements for U.S. No. 1, 2, 3, or 4; or
- b) Contain 4 or more stones which have an aggregate weight in excess of .1 percent of the sample weight, 1 or more pieces of broken glass, 3 or more Crotalaria seeds (Crotalaria spp.), 2 or more castor beans (Ricinus communis), 4 or more pieces of an unknown foreign substance(s) or a commonly recognized harmful or toxic foreign substance(s), 10 or more rodent pellets, bird droppings, or an equivalent quantity of other animal filth per 1,000 grams of soybeans; or a cumulative total of 11 or more of any combination of these sample grade factors; or
- c) Have a musty, sour, or commercially objectionable foreign odor (except garlic odor); or
- d) Are heating or otherwise of distinctly low quality
